EVENT DESCRIPTION: The PUR Tour provides quality racing for all categories with an emphasis on juniors and beginner riders!

THE COURSE: Is a non-technical 1.56 mile loop circuit of excellent pavement closed to traffic during the races. There is one left hand turn and 1 short climb. Wind is frequently present. Fitness, pack skills and teamwork are the most important factors.

DIRECTIONS: From Cincinnati – Proceed North on I-71 for approximately 20 miles to Exit 19 Mason-Montgomery/Fields Ertel Road. Turn left off of the exit onto Mason-Montgomery Rd. Proceed about 2 miles and turn right into the Procter & Gamble Health Care Research Center (use 2nd entrance). From Columbus: South on I-71 to exit 19. Turn right on to Mason-Montgomery Rd. Proceed to the P&G entrance (right side).

REGISTRATION: **\$5.00 Day of race late fee** for all categories except juniors and beginners. Cash or Check payable to QCW. \$5.00 discount for second, third races. Juniors who enter a junior event may enter a 2nd race for \$5.00.

- USCF license required for all racers except Kids on Bikes. Annual and 1-day licenses Available day of race. One days are \$10.
- Junior and/or Kids on Bikes - Racers **must** have parent or legal guardian sign waiver, available online or at the race. No exceptions possible.
- Kids on Bikes Time Trial - This is an individual event at a designated distance. Racers start at 10 second intervals and complete 1, 2 or 3 laps as fast as possible. Two wheels only. No training wheels.
- Junior gear restrictions apply - Rollouts will be performed on race day. (for details – see p 29 of USCF Rulebook at www.usacycling.org)
- Races held rain or shine – Only severe conditions such as lightning will delay / cancel.
- On site registration - Opens 1-hour before 1st event. Closes 15 minutes before each event
- Fields & Prize List – May be combined or changed based upon number of riders
- Helmets Are Mandatory - All riders must wear an ANSI approved, properly fitted helmet during both warm-up and racing.
- In Race 9, Espoirs are eligible for both Espoirs purse AND overall purse (\$600 total).
- Tandem Race: Prizes in 3 categories: Man/Man, Man/Woman, and Junior Stokers. Jrs. may be up to 16 years in age.
