Race Rules

- You must present a valid 2009 USCF license at registration to enter any race. Only Category 5 Men and Category 4 Women who do not have a valid racing license may purchase a one-day license for \$10.00 at registration.
- The promoters of the Tour de Olmsted reserve the right to lengthen, shorten, modify, cancel or combine races and/or prize list if insufficient entries, bad weather, dangerous conditions, insufficient support staff or other conditions beyond promoter's control.
- These are USA Cycling sanctioned races, all rules apply. Scoring for Series General Classification will conform to USA Cycling rules.
- Helmets required.
- Portion of the circuit race course and family ride will be reduced for one-lane, one-way vehicular traffic. Riders should not expect an entirely closed public thoroughfare. Riders should observe one lane traffic rules indicated by cones where the "YELLOW LINE RULE" will be enforced.
- Juniors must do the "rollout" procedure before and after their race.

Directions:

From Downtown Louisville: I-65 S toward NASHVILLE. Merge onto I-264 W/US-60 W via EXIT 131-B. Take the TAYLOR BLVD SOUTH/KY-1865 exit, EXIT 9. Turn LEFT onto TAYLOR BLVD/KY-1865. Continue to follow KY-1865. Turn RIGHT into AMPHITHEATER parking lot in Iroquois Park, Louisville, KY 40214

From Cincinnati: I-71 S toward CINCINNATI (Crossing into KENTUCKY). Merge onto I-71 S via EXIT 173 toward LOUISVILLE. Merge onto I-264 W via EXIT 5 on the LEFT. Take the TAYLOR BLVD SOUTH/KY-1865 exit, EXIT 9. Turn LEFT onto TAYLOR BLVD/KY-1865. Continue to follow KY-1865. Turn RIGHT into AMPHITHEATER parking lot in Iroquois Park, Louisville, KY 40214

From Lexington: I-64 W toward LOUISVILLE. Merge onto I-264 W/ US-60 W via EXIT 12. Take the TAYLOR BLVD SOUTH/ KY-1865 exit, EXIT 9. Turn LEFT onto TAYLOR BLVD/ KY-1865. Continue to follow KY-1865. Turn. Turn RIGHT into AMPHITHEATER parking lot in Iroquois Park, Louisville, KY 40214



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
